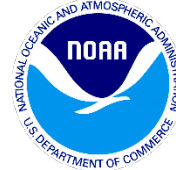




NOAA Undergraduate Scholarships

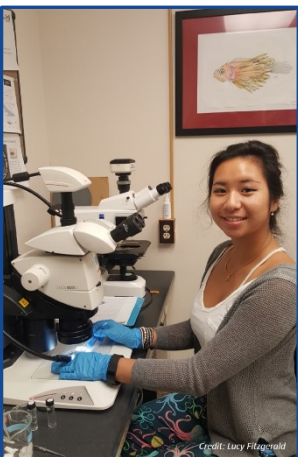


Ernest F. Hollings Undergraduate Scholarship

The Hollings Scholarship provides successful applicants with awards that include academic assistance (up to \$9,500 per year) for two years of full-time study and a 10-week, full-time paid summer internship at any NOAA facility nationwide, with travel expenses included. Scholars also receive support to present their research at up to two national conferences.



Educational Partnership Program Undergraduate Scholarship



The EPP/MSI Undergraduate Scholarship provides awards of up to \$9,500 per year for two years of study to rising juniors at Minority-Serving Institutions, who are majoring in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) fields that directly support NOAA's mission. EPP/MSI Scholars conduct research at NOAA facilities during two 10-week, full-time paid summer internships. Scholars also receive support to present their research at up to two national conferences.
